This unit looks at both the early church and modern examples of Christians who live out their faith. This also includes an investigation of the importance of the community of Saints	A study of the death and resurrection of Jesus, its features and significance. In particular how the story of the resurrection influences modern practices, including the Easter Triduum in the Catholic Tradition.	This is a story of the Catholic church from the first British Martyrs, the Church through the Reformation and Emancipation. It includes a study of the Second Vatican Council and some key documents of the Church	This is an exploration of a World Faith. This gives a framework of the Islamic faith and how it is experienced in Britain today. It provides a format of how to discuss and explore the key elements of religious practices and influences of religious belief.	The first two weeks are dedicated to revision and End of Year assessment. The final four weeks are a study of the importance of faith and an introduction to Hinduism. Links and comparisons are made to previous studies of Judaism, Christianity and Sikhism
