From September 2023, we have updated our dress code policy. It is important that all our Sixth Form students adhere to this new policy.

Expected dress code	Additional guidance
Suit or smart tailored trousers.	No denim.No casual trousers or leggings.
Smart skirt/ dress.	 Skirts and dresses must be of an appropriate length. No tube/ bandage skirt or bandage dress of any length.
Smart shirt with tie or smart blouse, (tie is optional in the summer term).	No polo shirt.No t-shirts.
Smart shoes.	No trainers/ pumps/ mules/ sliders.
 Smart jumper or cardigan (optional for the cold weather). 	No sports top.No hoodies/ sweatshirts.No logos.

In addition to the above:

- no hats or coats to be worn inside
- no extreme hair or makeup
- no headphones/ air pods to be worn outside of the Sixth Form area or library.

Students who arrive at Sixth Form inappropriately or too casually dressed will be asked to return home to change and will need to make up for any learning time missed.
