Don't be afraid to ask the teacher, if things aren't working for you in your lessons.

Come and ask for help!
You will meet me early on in year seven and also other pupils with dyslexia, so that you can support each other.

You are at secondary school now, so your teacher won't tell you what to do all the time, you will also have to be responsible.
Remember your glasses and overlay if you need them.
