Post 16 Bursary Scheme 2024-2025

1. The school will allocate a bursary grant to Year 12/13 students (after entry into Sixth form September 2024).
2. Students will be eligible for a grant if they receive free school meals or have provided proof of family income below £25,000 per annum including all benefits.
3. Students allocated a bursary grant will be able to use their grant to support their sixth form studies- The school will purchase the items listed in appendix 1 to support successful outcomes in Post 16.
4. A small termly attendance payment will be paid directly into a student's account if a student has 100% attendance.
5. The sum available is limited. The amount for each bursary account will be dependent on the number of students eligible. A contingency will be retained by the school to assist students whose circumstances change during the academic year.
6. An enhanced bursary is available for students who are LAC or LILAC with the local authority or have recently left local authority care. Applications for this should be made direct to the school via Mr Carpenter.
